Mr. Stuewe is presently a project manager at Los Alamos National Laboratory, a \$2B organization operated by Los Alamos National Security, LLC, for the National Nuclear Security Agency. Most recently he led the project to design and implement the Laboratory's Contractor Assurance System. With degrees in Nuclear Engineering, Mr. Stuewe has been a manager for >18 years in the areas of information technology, risk management services, and organizational improvement. Mr. Stuewe has participated in five MBNQA site visits in the Healthcare and Business sectors, three of which he led. He has also been a QNM applicant, served as an QNM examiner for 5 years, and is presently beginning his fifth year of service on the QNM Panel of Judges as the Lead Judge for the New Mexico Quality Awards.
